ADDENDUM

Adjusted Nursery Recommendations

To comply with the COVID-19 recommendations set by the Governor, we will be implementing the following policy changes in SHBC Nursery:

- 1. Nursery workers must:
 - a. Arrive and be ready to receive children 20 minutes prior to service time.
 - b. Sanitize hands before entering.
 - i. Always keep hands clean.
 - ii. Always wear gloves while changing diapers.
 - c. Have their temperature taken. Please refer to the Stoplight graphic for more information.
 - d. Remove shoes.
 - e. Wear a smock provided by the church.
 - f. Wear a filtered mask, covering nose and mouth.
 - g. Try to maintain physical distancing of 6-ft with other workers.
 - h. Not volunteer if they are feeling ill.
 - i. Not volunteer if they are in a "vulnerable" category or if they care for someone in the "vulnerable" category.
 - j. Place all belongings (including shoes) on proper hooks out of reach of children.
 - k. Not eat or drink in the nursery.
 - I. Sanitize every surface and toy after each service.
- 2. Parents/family dropping off children must:
 - a. Not enter the nursery. A worker will meet you at the door to greet children and get their belongings. At close, a worker will meet you with your children/belongings.
 - b. Maintain physical distancing of 6-ft with nursery workers.
 - c. Stay 6-ft away from open nursery doors.
 - d. Sanitize children's hands before they enter.
- 3. Children must:
 - a. Have their hands sanitized before entering nursery.
 - b. Have their shoes removed upon entering nursery.
 - c. Have their temperature taken by a nursery worker before entering nursery. Please refer to Stoplight graphic for more information.

The only people allowed in the nursery during this time are SCHEDULED NURSERY WORKERS, CHILDREN, NURSERY COORDINATOR, CUSTODIAN, and the PASTOR. Anyone else must not enter.
